Points of Measure (POM)

How to measure

Match code in POM column in tech pack with POM code on measuring guide. Follow written instructions and illustrations for correct measurement method.

Bottoms	14 - 38
Tops	38 - 70

Construction Standards for TravelSmith Garments

All information is general. Tech pack will have specific information.

Needles

- Knits must be sewn with ball point needles
- Wovens must be sewn with sharp point needles
- Leather and vinyl must be sewn with a wedge point needle
- Correct needle size for the material must be used.
- No excess needle holes in completed garments are allowed
- All finished garments must be checked for broken needles.

Fabrics

- First quality fabrics must be used no seconds
- Each lot must be cut from only one shade of the fabric, same grain direction and pattern; related separates must all be the same shade with the same color name. TravelSmith cannot sort by dye lot in the warehouse.
- Fabric must be inspected before cutting. Please forward fabric inspection report to TravelSmith.

Threads

- No monofilament thread
- Thread must match garment and trims unless specified as contrast
- Use polycore thread unless otherwise instructed.

Seams

- Seam slippage, ruptured or popping seams are not acceptable.
- Sewing tension must be adjusted properly for each fabric type. No skipped stitches, broken stitches, tangles or knots.
- Seam allowances should be even in width.
 - Crossed seams should be trimmed to reduce bulk.
 - Curved seams should be notched to lay flat.
 - Enclosed seams should be trimmed to reduce bulk.
 - Seams should be pressed open or to one side.
- All seams must be finished and secured. No loose threads.
- Knits must have stay tape at shoulders such as Mobilon or similar clear stay tape. Sweaters must have self knit or stay tape at shoulders.
- For knit seams, use at least a 4-thread mock safety stitch.
- For woven seams, use a 5-thread safety stitch seam
- For sheer fabrics, use French seams, mock French or flat-felled seams as indicated in the tech pack. Seams must pass seam slippage/seam strength testing.
- Rises and sleeve insertion seams should be sewn "on the round".
- Pleat/Vent tacking: If a style has pleats or vents at the bottom opening or hem, they must be tacked in place prior to shipping.

- Hand tack pleat or vent in place with an X stitch ¾" high. Position is 1/8" up from edge and 1/8" from fold.
- For Men's shirting, use flat-felled seams.
- For Men's Sport coats, center back seam must be pressed open.

<u>Hems</u>

- Blind hem should not be visible on the outside of the garment. Stitches and tension should be
 adjusted properly. Raw edge of hem must be finished. Raw edge finish is determined by fabric
 type and weight. Please confirm finish with Tech Dept.
- Blind hem stitching should follow SPI Chart, unless specified. Be sure to secure beginning and end of stitching so hem does not come out.
- Sleeves and bottom hems must be hemmed "on the round".
- Stitched hems Wovens clean finish any shirt tail or straight hems by turning in the raw edge and stitching or as indicated in the tech pack.
- Stitched hems Knits use cover stitch in width indicated in tech pack. Cover stitch must cover raw edges. For single needle clean finish, turn in edge and stitch. Perl edge is also an acceptable finish for knits. Refer to tech pack for correct finish to use.
- Hems should be lie flat, no roping.

Interlinings/Interfacings

- Use compatible fusible interlinings in weight and glue melting temperature with fabric, making sure heat attachment requirement does not damage the garment fabric.
- Fusible interlinings must not have bubbles or come loose, especially after washing or dry cleaning
- Fusible interlinings must not pill or disintegrate after washing or dry cleaning.
- Non fusible interlining may be used in some instances where fusible is not suitable. Please get approval of use from Production and Tech Depts.

Facings

- Facings must lie flat without pulling or strain.
- Facing edges must be clean finished .
- Facing width must be at least 3" wide at hem and allow for turn over without edges showing at neckline.
- Facings must have Interlining/Interfacing. See above for instructions.

Lining

- Lining fabric must be opaque to prevent show-through of construction details.
- Lining fabric must withstand garment care similar shrinkage rates within acceptable tolerance. Tolerance for differential shrinkage (between shell fabric and lining) is 2% maximum.
- Lining must fit smoothly inside garment, hanging straight without pulling with seams aligned with garment seams.
- Lining must have "ease" at CB seam, sleeve hem and at bottom hem. Lining hem must not hang below garment hem.
- Lining seams must be stitched securely and reinforced at stress points.


- Garment hems should be tacked at seams to prevent shifting of hem allowance and lining attached to raw edge. For jackets, lining should be tacked securely at underarm.
- For free hanging lining, hem garment and lining separately as per instructions in tech pack. Use French tacks to attach at seams. For outerwear, lining and garment can be attached using finished strips of fabric or other approved material.

Pockets


- Pockets must be uniform in size and shape.
- Pockets must be even horizontally unless otherwise indicated.
- Patch pockets -Top and Edge Stitches should be an equal distance from edge and each other.
 Beginning and ending stitches must be reinforced with a back stitch, bar tack or other reinforcement method indicated in the tech pack construction. Tack must not run off the pocket onto main garment piece.
- Side seam pockets reinforce at top and bottom of pocket opening with a back stitch, bar tack, or other reinforcement method indicated in tech pack.
- Pocket bags should use durable fabric approved by Production.
- Welt Pockets should have even sized welts and follow the tech pack for placement and construction.

Waistbands


- Elastic All elastic must be non roll and be attached to the waistband so it will not roll when being worn.
- Waistbands with fly front zippers or side zippers should have an inside button closure (clear button OK) and an outside closure.
- Waist self turn with 2 needle coverstitch ¼" gauge create waistband. Fully cover raw edge at inside. Overlap coverstitch at ends by a minimum of 1". Must be circular sewn.




• Waist self turn and turn elastic with elastic. Multi-needle chainstitch to create waistband. If Back only sides are to be clean finished.



• One piece separate waistband, clean finish folder set with a single needle chainstitch, lockstitch or multi needle chainstitch as indicated on spec.



• One piece separate waistband, overlock raw edges then top stitch if specified on tech pack.



Zippers

- Use only YKK zippers for all production unless otherwise approved by merchants/production.
- Zipper tape must match garments main color unless otherwise specified. The color must be approved by merchants/production. All zipper tape must be pre-shrunk.
- All bottoms such as pants, shorts, skirts etc. must use locking zippers.

- Separating zippers: For Women's, zipper slider should be on wearer's left. For Men's, zipper slider should be on wearer's right.
- For bottoms, space from the top of the zipper to waist should not be more than ¼".
- For tops, follow tech pack with instructions of how far from bottom and top opening the zipper should be.
- Zipper insertion should be smooth, no roping on garment or binding. Zippers must lay flat.
- No sharp points or unfinished edges on zipper teeth. Zipper stops must be secured so slider does not come off.
- Backstitch the bottom of all zippers. Bar tack only if indicated in the tech pack.
- All zippers with metal teeth should have a zipper guard unless otherwise specified in the tech pack.

Snaps, Hooks and Eyes, and Hook and Loop Fasteners

- Always reinforce placement with interlining/interfacing if less than 3 layers of fabric.
- Snaps must be applied properly, must withstand pull test of 15lbs/10 seconds.
- Place fasteners at least 1/8" from edge of garment or as indicated in the tech pack.
- Snap set must be aligned with correct placement of the two parts.
- Hooks and eyes must be applied with small, neat stitches that do not show on the right side of garment.
- Hook and eye closures must be securely attached by small stitches or by attachment method for closure.
- Hook and Loop Tape (Velcro®)- Loop side must be placed on the body/bottom and the hook side must be on the toplayer unless other wise specified, i.e. pocket flaps.
- All hook and loop tape that is rectangular or square must be rounded at the corners to avoid sharp edges. Corners can be die cut or hand cut.

Cuffs and Collars

- Use appropriate interfacing for collar and cuffs to maintain shape.
- Collar shape must be symmetrical on left and right.
- Collar must roll over smoothly or lie flat according to design.
- Only top collar should be visible. Under collar should not show. Collar should cover neck seam unless otherwise indicated in tech pack.
- Cuffs should be even in width.
- For two-piece cuff, the seams should be on the edge of the cuff.
- Cuffs and collars must be "clean-finished" with a single or double needle top stitch. No serged edge on the cuff, collar or collar band.

Under-stitching

- Use under-stitching to keep facings from rolling out for necklines, collars, cuffs or pocket linings.
- Should never be visible on outside of garment.
- Thread color should match fabric.

Top Stitch and Edge Stitch

- Top Stitches must be evenly stitched; see SPI specified on chart.
- Double needle Top Stitch must be a uniform width between needles in all garment areas.

• Adjust tension to avoid puckering in Top Stitched areas.

Buttons

• 2-hole buttons must be lock stitched to prevent them from falling off.



• 4-hole buttons must be cross stitched and lock stitched.




• Shank buttons for outerwear must be reinforced with a small button on the facing side. Thread must be secured with a whip stitch, not half stitches. If outside button does not have a shank, it must have a thread shank.



• For outerwear, a 2 or 4 hole button with thread shank should be used. Thread must be secured with a whipstitch, not half stitches. Button must have at least 6 loops of thread holding the button to the garment. Wind thread 2-3 times around thread loops.



 Necked shank button without a reinforcement button must have at least 6 loops of thread holding the button to the garment. Wind thread 2-3 times around thread loops (below shank) to neck button. Secure thread with a whipstitch. Do not pull thread too tightly so shank sinks into fabric.



• Reversible styles with buttons must have thread shanks on each side. Buttons must be easy to fasten on both sides.



• 2 hole or 4 hole buttons with a button backer: Backer Button does not need a thread shank however outer button must have either a thread shank or must be easy to fasten.



- Buttons must pass care label instructions and must not crack, chip, discolor, rust or melt.
- Buttons must pass lead in surface coating testing (16 CFR 1303) at >90 ppm.
- Must pass button pull test.

Buttonholes

- Buttonholes should be constructed with a top and bottom feed lockstitch sewing machine. See
 SPI for buttonholes on chart. Tension should be properly adjusted.
- For women's garments, buttonholes are on wearer's right unless otherwise specified.
- For men's garments, buttonholes are on wearer's left.
- Overlap should be wide enough to cover without a gap.
- The length of the buttonhole should be at least 1/8" longer than the ligne of the button plus button thickness.
- Buttonhole stitch width must be wide enough to not pull away from cut edge of fabric. Extra reinforcement must be used under buttonholes if fabric is very light weight or loosely woven. Use appropriate quality and color.
- For keyhole buttonholes, the tail on the keyhole must be short, neat and clean.
- To finish buttonhole, first neatly cut it open, then trim all fabric and threads closely. No loose threads are allowed.

<u>Sweaters</u>

- Float length should be no longer than 1".
- Seams must stretch to maximum stretch of knit panels/fabric without breaking.
- Side vents must be clean finished with tubular, rib knit, hand crochet or self start. Tech pack will confirm preference.
- Beads or sequins must be knotted after every fifth bead.
- Shoulder seams must have self knit or stay tape.
- All internal seams except for shoulder must be linked except where specified otherwise.
- Linking tension should be the same on all seams within a garment.
- Linked seams must stretch to the maximum stretch of knit panels without breaking.
- Necklines with tubular or rib trim should have closing seam placed at HPS on wearer's right.
- Closed necklines should meet minimum stretch requirements without breaking stitches.
- Sweater starts on neck, sleeve, and bottom opening are ribbed, tubular, self start or self yarn crochet.
- Tighten tension ½" on all rib starts unless otherwise indicated.

Pressing and Finishing

During Construction:

All woven side seams and inseams that are not top stitched should be pressed towards the back.
 No twisting of seams allowed.

- Press all dart seam allowances toward center of garment or towards hem.
- All pleat seam allowances to be pressed toward side seam or garment unless otherwise specified.

Finishing:

- Garment surface is smooth and free of wrinkles. No puckering of seams or other construction details.
- No overpressing or iron imprints.
- No shine, scorching or melting allowed.
- Inside construction details should not show on outside.
- No stretching or shrinking, no water marks or mineral spots allowed.
- Seams and darts are pressed smoothly on the stitching lines. Fabric can not fold over stitching line or look bubbled.

Labels and Tags

- All care labels must be sewn to the inside of garment as specified.
- Care labels and printing must last for the normal life of the garment.
- Care information must conform to Federal Trade Commission rulings and be legible and consistent with third party test reports and other hang tags.
- Fiber content wording cannot be abbreviated, must add up to 100% (with greatest percentage first), use generic names (not trade names) and conform to the Federal Trade commission rulings on labeling. http://www.ftc.gov/os/statutes/textile/rr-texl.shtm
- Fiber content must be consistent with third party test reports and any other hang tags.
- Any TravelSmith hang tags or labels as specified in the tech pack.
- All other relevant Federal Trade Commission labeling regulations must be followed.
- Any hang tags with claims must have scientific laboratory testing for validation. This includes all
 off-line buys.
- Website addresses and retail pricing should NOT be included on hang tags.
